## IF YOUR PET IS UNDER ANESTHESIA, WE MAY NEED TO REACH YOU QUICKLY

**Pre-Anesthetic Bloodwork** Recommended before ANY anesthetic procedure. This bloodwork will alert the doctor to the presence of certain medical conditions which could possibly complicate the procedure as well as check the functions of your pet's internal organs and provide a picture of your pet's overall health. It will also serve as a baseline to compare with should you pet ever need bloodwork in the future. **Patients 7 years and older present a higher risk of complications and are required to have pre-anesthetic bloodwork performed unless a profile has been run in the last six months. **I.V. Catheter & Fluids** We strongly recommend this with all anesthetic procedures for the best care of your pet. If you would like to decline this option, a doctor will consult with you to ensure you understand the risks. I.V. Catheters are placed to administer fluids before, during and after the procedure. I.V. Fluids help support organ function and maintain blood pressure during the procedure, as well as keep your pet hydrated. Also, should any unforeseen complications arise while your pet is under anesthesia, your pet will have the advantage of having an I.V. already placed for administering medication. **(For IV Catheter placement, a portion of your pet's leg(s) will be shaved.)**

If my dog is determined by the doctor to be obese at the time of surgery, there will be an additional charge of \$38.50, and if my dog is in heat and being spayed, there will be an additional charge of \$46.50. These additional charges are incurred because of the extra time and effort involved in working around these conditions. I have been advised as to the nature of the procedures and the risks involved. I realize that results cannot be guaranteed. I hereby consent and authorize this hospital to perform the above anesthetic procedures and/or surgery. I understand the doctors and staff will use all reasonable precaution against injury, escape, and/or death of my pet. I understand that all anesthesia involves some degree of risk and I will not hold the doctors or staff responsible under any circumstances. I understand that I assume all risks.
